Glory to God! Glory to God!



"Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened."


So they hurried off and found Mary and Joseph and saw the baby lying in the manger.




Some wise men came to look for Jesus.

There were six stone water jars.




Jesus said to the servants, "Fill these jars with water."

The man in charge tasted the water that had turned into wine.


He did not know where this wine had come from.



So he called the bridegroom and said to him,


"Everyone else serves the best wine first.

But you have kept the best wine until now!"




Jesus did this first miracle in Cana.



When he saw the man, he passed by, on the other side.




In the same way,

came along.




He went over and looked at the man and then walked past, on the other side.



But a man from the country of Samaria was travelling along the road.






When he saw the poor man who had been beaten up by robbers, he felt sorry for him and went over to him.



Jesus and the storm





Jesus got into a boat.

They started across to the other side of the lake.








The waves began to spill over into the boat, and the boat was about to sink.

But Jesus was still asleep.




The disciples went to Jesus and woke him up.

He ordered the winds and the waves to stop.


"Be quiet!" Jesus said.





Everybody knew him.






Zacchaeus was a rich man who lived in Jericho.

"Hurry down, Zacchaeus.


I must stay in your house today."

I have come to save people who are lost."





Then they took Jesus


to the High Priest.

She was standing near John, the friend Jesus loved.


Jesus said to his mother, "He is your son."

That same day two men were going to Emmaus.


They were talking about all that happened.

Jesus said to them, "It is I myself."




They were full of joy.

They knew that Jesus was alive!


